

**RESOLUTION NO. 2021-01
TOWN OF MILTON, BUFFALO COUNTY**

RESOLUTION REGARDING WARD PLAN

WHEREAS, Wisconsin Statute Section 5.15 requires the creation of municipal wards by all cities, villages and towns with a population of 1,000 or more;

WHEREAS, the same statute does not require towns or villages with less than a population of 1,000 to be divided into wards, but allows them to do so to help facilitate elections;

WHEREAS, the Town of Milton is currently not divided into wards;

WHEREAS, the Town of Milton, per the 2020 census, has a population of 541;

WHEREAS, the Town Board of the Town of Milton has reviewed the supervisory redistricting plan for Buffalo County which provides for no changes since the 2011 redistricting plan and which includes the entire township in District 10;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Town of Milton does not object to the County's proposed redistricting plan and will not divide into wards.


The town clerk shall properly post or publish this resolution as required by law under Sec. 60.80 of Wis. Statutes within 30 days of the below noted adoption date.
