

**TOWN OF MILTON**

**RESOLUTION NO. 2022-1**

The Town Board of the Town of Milton having been approached by the local Snowmobile Club (Hilltop TrailBlazers) for permission to allow use of the Town Highway known as Waumandee Creek Road, lying between State Road 88 and Canada Ridge Road, to be used as a designated snowmobile trail because of discrete terrain related conditions preventing snowmobiles from traveling in adjacent highway off road right-of-way; and

The Town Board has concluded the request to be reasonable under the circumstances;

**NOW THEREFORE**, pursuant to the authority granted the Town Board to designate highways as routes upon which snowmobiles may be operated, per Wis Stat. Sec. 350.02(2)(a)5,

**THE TOWN BOARD DOES HEREBY RESOLVE** as follows:

Unless and until modified by the Town Board, that portion of the traveled surface of Waumandee Creek Road lying between State Road 88 and Canada Ridge Road is hereby designated as a snowmobile route.


The Hilltop TrailBlazers Snowmobile Association shall be responsible for procuring and paying for signs designating this stretch of Town Highway as a snowmobile trail, and the signs erected (by the Town) shall comply with all requirements of the State Statutes concerning highway signage.

The Hilltop TrailBlazers Snowmobile Association (or its successors) shall be responsible for installing separate snowmobile directional and guidance signs along this snowmobile route, and where reasonably feasible, direct snowmobile traffic to use Town Road right-of-way inasmuch as reasonably possible rather than using highway surface area.
